Dear Center Cass Families,

I am writing to inform you that over the last week, we have seen a major uptick in COVID cases.

In total from this last week we had 31 cases reported.

- 3 Positive Student Cases from Elizabeth Ide
- 19 Positive Student Cases from Prairieview
- 7 Positive Student Cases from Lakeview
- 2 Positive Adult Cases from Prairieview

Even though our uptick in COVID cases is pre-dominantly in our 9 through 12-year-old population, other area school districts are seeing the same uptick throughout all their age levels.

As we enter a time of higher transmission, please

- Consider wearing a facial covering
- Consider washing and sanitizing hands more frequently
- Consider increasing distance between you and others

Until the spike subsides, we will be looking at ways to space kids out a little more, especially during times when their masks are off.

As we enter May, the amount of after school and evening activities increase. Most of these events are outside, but some are inside. **For inside events, please take the level of caution you feel comfortable with to protect yourself and others.** The principals and nursing department will be monitoring new cases closely this week and will provide you an update next week.
