Welding Technology I and II


Welding Technology is a technical trade program. It is conducted in partnership with Hutchinson Community College and is a two-year half-day program of study comprised of 13 college level courses. The welding program is designed to provide students with a direct pathway to a job as a welder. Students who wish to be considered for enrollment should be pursuing a career path in the welding career field. This is a dual credit (high school and college) series of classes offered to students at no tuition cost (about a \$6,000 value) other than some material fees and personal equipment. To be eligible for enrollment, students must complete the attached application with two reference forms then return it to the CTE Director, Ben Reed, during or prior to the student interview. References must be of a professional nature and therefore the student should solicit employers, teachers, administrators of other persons who would have an objective knowledge of their motivation, ability, and work ethic. There is a \$100.00 material fee per year to take this program payable no later than the first day of class. No student will be considered for final enrollment until the application and interview process is fully complete.


