SCHOOL BOARD POLICY - JFCEB PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES AND SOCIAL MEDIA

<u>STUDENT/PARENT HANDBOOK SINCE 2010 - REVISED IN</u> <u>2016, AND AGAIN IN 2021.</u>

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Student-owned personal electronic devices (PED) such as tablets, smart phones, cell phones, iPods, etc. are only allowed for student use during the following designated times: before school, passing periods, lunch, and after school.

Personal electronic devices are only allowed for use in a class during specific teacher-directed educational activities, and should be off and out of sight at all other times. Students and parents must be aware that personal electronic devices will not receive maintenance work by the school's technology department. Students who bring these devices to school do so at their own risk and they will not be replaced or repaired by the school district if they are lost, stolen, or damaged. Cyberbullying and academic dishonesty with any electronic device is prohibited. Violators will face disciplinary action, may not be allowed to have the PED at school, and could lose all district technology/internet privileges.

Why now?

THE REALITY......

- 32% OF STUDENTS <u>THIS YEAR</u> AT STANFIELD SECONDARY SCHOOL TESTED 3 OR MORE GRADE LEVELS BELOW IN MATH BASED ON DIAGNOSTIC DATA FROM IREADY.

More reality......

Up to this point in the school year, I have processed **138** discipline referrals for things such as TARDIES, SKIPPING, TOBACCO, VAPING, DRUGS, BULLYING, FIGHTING, PORNOGRAPHY, INNAPROPRIATE SEARCHES, VANDALISM, INSUBORDINATION, CHEATING, AND MORE...

Of those 138 referrals over 70% can be tied directly or indirectly to improper cell phone use in the school.

There is a very strong correlation between cell phone use and the negative things happening here on campus.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF STUDENTS...

- IF A TEACHER DEEMS THAT A CELL
 PHONE IS NECESSARY FOR A SPECIFIC
 EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITY, THAT CAN'T
 BE ACCOMPLISHED WITH THE
 CHROMEBOOK, THEY HAVE THE
 DISCRETION TO ALLOW A PHONE TO BE
 TAKEN FROM THE WALL HOLDER AND
 USED FOR THAT ACTIVITY. PH UPON
 ENTERING THE CLASSROOM, PLACE CELL
 PHONE IN CLEAR HOLDER ON THE WALL
 IN YOUR CLASSROOM.
- ONES SHOULD BE RETURNED TO THE WALL HOLDER WHEN TASK IS COMPLETED.
- PHONES BEING USED IN THE CLASSROOM SHOULD BE ON OR ABOVE THE DESK AT ALL TIMES.
- ANY PHONE NOT PLACED IN THE HOLDER AT THE BEGINNING OF CLASS MAY NOT BE USED AT ANY TIME DURING THE PERIOD.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A STUDENT DOES NOT COMPLY?

1ST OFFENSE: CONFISCATE THE ELECTRONIC DEVICE, BRING THAT DEVICE TO OFFICE WITH A REFERRAL ATTACHED, WHERE A STUDENT MAY PICK IT UP AFTER THEY SERVE A DETENTION.

2ND OFFENSE: CONFISCATE THE DEVICE. BRING THAT DEVICE TO THE OFFICE WITH A REFERRAL ATTACHED. STUDENT'S PARENTS MAY PICK UP THE DEVICE AT THEIR CONVENIENCE. FRIDAY SCHOOL ASSIGNED.

3RD OFFENSE: CONFISCATE THE DEVICE. BRING THAT DEVICE TO THE OFFICE WITH A REFERRAL ATTACHED. STUDENTS PARENTS MAY PICK UP THE DEVICE AT THEIR CONVENIENCE. (ISS) ASSIGNED. STUDENT WILL NO LONGER BE ALLOWED TO BRING THE DEVICE TO SCHOOL FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SCHOOL YEAR.
