  - i. Highlighted the upcoming Winter concert. Tickets are free but limited due to COVID.
  - ii. Noted that the club auditions would be held next Monday for the spring musical Mama Mia.
  - iii. Recapped that a student performer was featured in a news article about the Nutcracker performance; Nutcracker event is scheduled this weekend at 2 pm and 7 pm.
  - iv. Updated the School Committee that the School Backpack program "Boxes for Joy" was coming to a close; working with the counselors positively impacted deliveries to go directly to the families.
- 3. Sanford School Department Safe Return to School and Continuity of Instruction Plan 2021-2022 Update
  - 1. Superintendent Nelson reviewed current COVID-19 statistics.
    - York County community transmission remains high, Sanford student and staff vaccination rates are slowly increasing as are pooled testing numbers.
    - ii. Positivity rate was at 11.01%.
    - iii. Maine Labor Board met last week; no update yet in terms of deciding requirements for staff vaccinations. Once established, there will be 30 days to adhere.
    - iv. DHHS suspended reporting staff vaccinations.
    - v. Subs are needed; working with EdTechs and Teachers to cover. Not all absences are COVID related.

- Reports provide scores for each skill area to determine strengths, areas to improve and overall scores.
  - Information about the instructional level of the student.
  - A road map for students towards achieving mastry.
- · Not a test for determining mastery of skills.
- Scores were reviewed:
  - All 3 elementary school were consistent in findings.
  - Scores are compared nationally.
  - · Regress in scores was expected.
  - Meet students where they are and supported them in gaining a years' worth of growth was the goal.
  - Student sliding down as getting older; no motivation or focus. Goal is to see growth in the Spring.
  - These scores will help in planning budgets for the fall.
  - Job to keep in proper perspective; great growth meter.
