VIII. Distribution/Discussion of the Code of Ethics for School Board Members pursuant to the School Ethics Act (c.178, P. L. 2001)

Be It Resolved, that the Little Ferry Board of Education, individually and as a group, reaffirms and re-adopts the School Board Member Code of Ethics contained in Board of Education Bylaw 0142, as follows:

NJSBA Code of Ethics

The members of the Board of Education recognize that they hold authority not as individuals but as members of the Board. In order to make a clear public statement of its philosophy of service to the pupils of the district, the Board adopts as its own the School Board Member Code of Ethics promulgated by the New Jersey School Boards Association on May 10, 1975 and reproduced below:

I will uphold and enforce all laws, State Board rules and regulations, and court orders pertaining to schools. Desired changes should be brought about only through legal ethical procedures.

I will make decisions in terms of the educational welfare of children and will seek to develop and maintain public schools which meet the individual needs of all children regardless of their ability, race, creed, sex, or social standing.

I will confine my Board action to policymaking, planning, and appraisal and I will help to frame policies and plans only after the Board has consulted those who will be affected by them.

I will carry out my responsibility, not to administer the schools, but together with my fellow Board members, to see that they are well run.

I will recognize that authority rests with the Board of Education and will make no personal promises nor take any private action which may compromise the Board.

I will refuse to surrender my independent judgment to special interest or partisan, political groups or to use the schools for personal gain or for the gain of friends.

I will hold confidential all matters pertaining to the schools which, if disclosed, would needlessly injure individuals or the schools. But in all other matters, I will provide accurate information and, in concert with my fellow Board members, interpret to the staff the aspirations of the community for its schools.

I will vote to appoint the best-qualified personnel available after consideration of the recommendation of the chief administrative officer.

I will support and protect school personnel in proper performance of their duties.

I will refer all complaints to the chief administrative officer and will act on such complaints at public meetings only after failure of an administrative solution

Any Board of Education employee who orders and/or receives any goods and services without going through the approved purchase order process has made an unauthorized purchase. Unauthorized purchases are a violation of State Law N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-2(v) and N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-3(a). Board employees making unauthorized purchases are subject to disciplinary action as outlined by the Superintendent.
