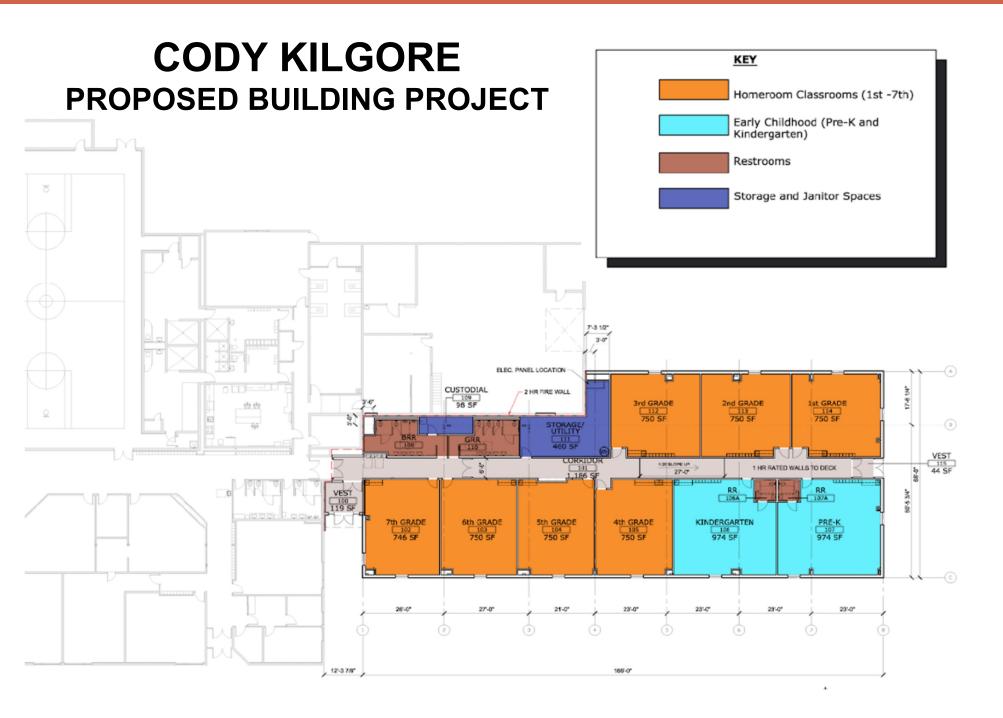
Public Information Meeting June 15, 2022

Steps Taken

- Heritage Homes came out and gave us a price per square foot. Ended up being similar in price to current plan.
- Having selecting Ayars & Ayars it didn't make sense to completely start the entire process over again.
- Talked to Ayars & Ayars about putting together two more plans. One basic plan to see what you could get for the \$3 million and one with reduced square footage to bring the cost down.
- Formed a Capital Campaign Committee. This Committee is focused on finding upfront fundraising for the project.
- Town Hall Meeting- Was set up to inform Patrons on where the School Board is at, and get input on building plan options, and what kind of bond amount was acceptable.

Steps Taken

- Fundraising Committee met regularly to discuss where the fundraising process was at and what the next steps were
- Fundraising website launched
- Reviewed options for a Project Manager
- Ayars & Ayars designed a building that met the immediate needs of the district
- Building Committee met with Project Controls to discuss total cost of the project
- School Board met twice every month starting in February to continue the work on the Building Project
- Town Hall Meeting June 15, 2022 to update Patrons on where the project is at
