- 6:45 Parent pick-up in classroom

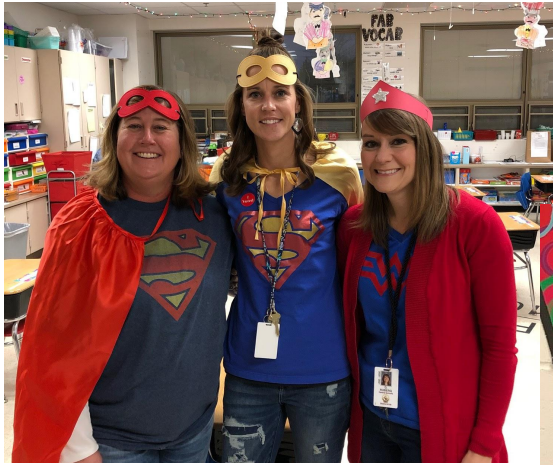

CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Reading/Language Arts

- Phonics (letter names and sounds/sounding out words)
- Phonemic awareness (rhyming, recognizing individual sounds in a word)
- Vocabulary
- Comprehension
- Writing (Opinion, Informative, and Narrative)
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Mathematics

- Counting (rote count to 31 by the end of the year)
- Identify and write numbers to 31
- Patterns
- Shapes
- Compose and decompose numbers
- Introduction to addition and subtraction
- Introduction to measurement (length, weight, area, and volume)

Science-FOSS New this year

- Hands-on-made particle board
- Interactive- games and videos
- Includes Experiments-how many paperclips to sink the boat
- Enriches Vocabulary- words such as pulp, bumpy, texture, etc.

CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Gym

- The students will be inside and outside for P.E. class. Gym shoes are a requirement for inside P.E. Students participate in P.E. 5 times per week.

Music

- Students participate in music 5 times per week. During the spring they will present a musical to their friends and families.

Library

- The students will have the opportunity to check out a book 2-3 times per week.

Computers

- Students will be introduced to the basics of a computer and computer safety. Curriculum will include eSparks, Splash Math, Epic, ABC Mouse and Starfall.
- Students spend on average 20 minutes on chromebooks each day.

DAILY ROUTINES

- **Recess before school starts**
- **Get ready for the day/Morning Meeting**- The day begins at 8:05 (hang up coats, put away folders, find their spot at the carpet, be ready for morning meeting)
- **Snack time**- Students will be asked to provide a snack either daily or monthly depending on teacher (Milk is free in Kindergarten)
- **Lunch Routine**- Set up school lunch account for your child prior to first day. Students can also bring their own lunch from home. (home lunch can get milk at an additional charge) Students go to lunch around 11:00 followed by recess.
- **Rest time**- Please provide a towel (not a blanket) for your child to use at rest time.
- **Free time**- Students will have 20 minutes of free play daily.
- **Pack up**- Students will do sharing/ show and tell during this time. They will also pack folders and get ready to go home. The day ends at 3:03 for kindergarten.

Academic Routine includes:

- **Reading** (90 minutes) phonics, writing and reading skills. This also includes guided reading time and centers.
- **Math** (90 minutes) Includes centers and skills such as patterns, number recognition and writing, and to 110.
- **Social Studies, Science, and Health**- These are taught in the afternoon on a rotating basis.

Central School's Construction Process

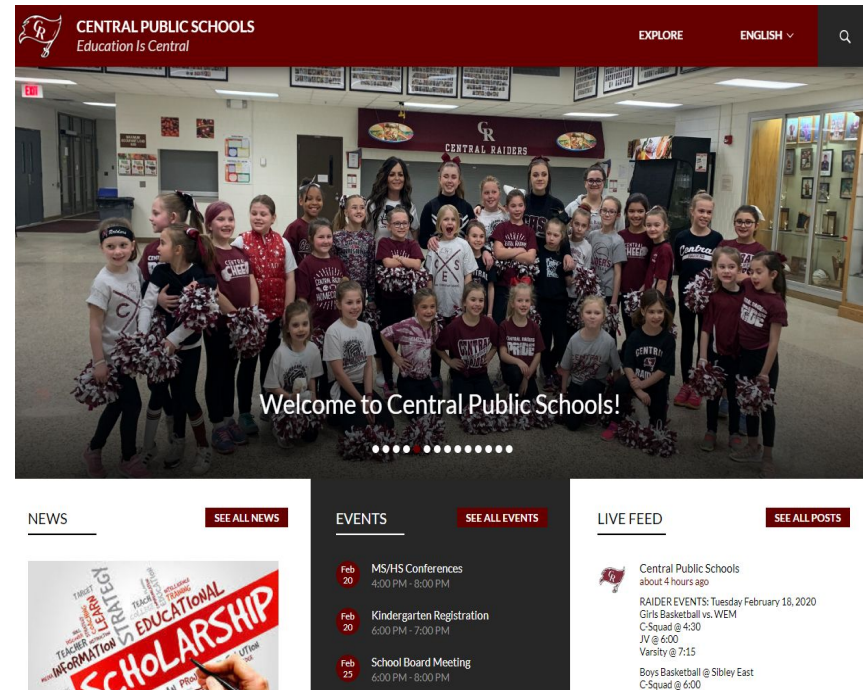
