Scholarship Criteria

1. Sutherlin High School Graduate
2. Minimum 2.5 GPA

Application Requirements

1. High school transcripts must be attached to application.
2. Extra-Curricular Activities: List of extra-curricular activities, awards and letters received, offices held, and related achievements in and out of school grades 9-12. (Student **MUST** have participated in school related extra-curricular activities, clubs, or sports to be eligible for this scholarship.)
3. Three Letters of Recommendation must be submitted with application.
 - (1) from a teacher
 - (1) from an advisor, activity leader, or coach
 - (1) from a community member, **not** associated/employed by Sutherlin High School
4. Personal Statement: Briefly note your future plans and career goals. Explain why you have selected your career field.

Selection Criteria:

1. Scholastic achievement, honors, and awards.
2. Degree of participation in extra-curricular activities at Sutherlin High School, and civic activities.
3. School contribution and volunteering in Booster sponsored events or fundraisers.
4. Life lesson at Sutherlin High School essay.

(*finalists will be notified, and required to participate in an interview with scholarship selection committee before final awards are decided.)

Winners will be announced at the Senior Awards Assembly.

Payment:

A one-time pay of funds received from the scholarship will be made payable to the awarded student in late June, following graduation. Funds are intended to be used to pay tuition, fees, or living costs associated with post high school education or training.
