Colton-Pierrepont is a comprehensive K-12 public school, enrolling 117 students in grades 9-12.

Colton-Pierrepont is located in the town of Colton, a small, rural town on the northern outskirts of the Adirondack Mountains, with a population of 1,424.

GPA Calculation

Beginning with grade nine, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation, in addition to accelerated math and science, and the foreign language course in grade 8. All grades at Colton-Pierrepont are unweighted, and are graded on a 100 point scale.

Curriculum

The academic program is organized on a semester schedule. Courses generally meet 5 days per week for 40 minutes. Graduation Credit Requirements are a minimum of 22 credits.
