There is a new free resource for anyone in NH! If you or a loved one is in a behavioral health crisis and in need of immediate support you can call, text, or chat with trained staff 24 hours a day. Depending on the specific situation support can be provided over the phone, giving access to outpatient services, or in person through the Crisis Response team.








Over the phone support with referrals to outpatient services, or to have a Mobile Crisis Response Team (MCRT) come to you at a place of your choice.
