## Hello Randolph Central Families!

- 1. Effective immediately, contact tracing and all remaining COVID-specific control measures are ended within the Randolph Central School Corporation.
- 2. Student exclusion for COVID-19 will be the same as seasonal influenza or other viral illness as was our practice prior to the pandemic. Students must be without symptoms and fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication before returning to school. Parents are encouraged to communicate with our school nurses when students are ill as was our practice prior to the pandemic.
- 3. Effective February 23, 2022, the Indiana State Department of Health will no longer require the reporting of positive cases by schools.
- 4. The CDC still recommends that Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 should isolate for five days.
- 5. Students in a home where someone else is COVID-19 positive do not need to quarantine.
