LAYTONVILLE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT VAN/DISTRICT VEHICLE DRIVER

<u>Definition:</u> Under the general supervision of the Director of Maintenance, Grounds and Transportation or designee, transports students to and from school, using a district van carrying seven passengers or less.

Examples of Duties:

- Perform daily pre-trip inspection of vehicle. E
- Transport children to and from school. E
- Sweep and clean interior of vehicle. E
- Wash exterior of vehicles as needed E
- Wash and fuel vehicle as needed. E
- Maintain records of mileage and vehicle condition. E
- May transport children on field trips, athletic events, and to other school sponsored events when applicable. E
- Provide a positive and welcoming school transportation environment (greetings and farewell).
- Complete all required paper work such as incident reports, repair needs, etc. E
- Other related duties as assigned. E

Minimum Qualifications:

- Education equivalent to graduation from high school.
- Must have a valid class C motor vehicle license.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Experience working with children in a group setting.
- Formal education or training in child behavior or psychology.

Licenses and Certificates Required:

- Valid Class C motor vehicle license.
- Current first aid and CPR certification.

Physical Abilities Required:

- Ability to drive for up to 8 hours per day.
- Sufficient flexibility to bend and stretch while cleaning vehicles.
- Participate in pre-employment drug test and random drug/alcohol pull program
