Enclosed is the application for your students to apply for the Colorado Society of Mayflower Descendants scholarship. Please make copies of this form to give out to any senior interested in applying. They do not have to be a Mayflower Descendant. Each year we present up to two seniors with a one-time scholarship for \$1620. The full amount is paid directly to the college, university or other institution where the student is enrolled with instructions that the amounts be applied to each of that year's semesters evenly. This is a one time scholarship, paid the summer before the student's first semester. The applications need to be emailed or postmarked by May 1, 2022.
