We will be following strict COVID-19 precautions. All students and persons accompanying them must wear a mask at all times. Students must arrive on time to sign in and prepare for testing.

Prior to testing, we have to gather pertinent information in a timely manner to verify that your applicant meets all of the requirements. **All applicants must have a 3.0 GPA or higher to qualify for testing.** (You may submit two students, with one being an alternate.)

The application, student photo, and **official transcript** (sealed) should be received no later than March 31, 2022. **I cannot accept a photocopy of the transcript.** Make sure the **Worthy Matron's signature and the Chapter Seal** are on the application. Because the testing date follows shortly after this due date, please make sure all guidelines are adhered to because you will not have time to find an alternate student. You will be notified if your student does not qualify.

**Please note:** the top five applicants will take the *State Scholarship Test*. The State Scholarship chairperson, Sister Brenda Arnette has not received confirmation on a date or location from the Grand Worthy Matron at the time of this letter. **You will be notified as soon as district chairpersons are provided with the testing location and date. There will only be one day the District and State Tests will be administered. Please make sure your student is available for both testing dates.**
