## Nurses and Other Substitute Information

2022-2023

## Substitute Nurse Tier Schedule:

All Substitute Nurses need to have their Registered Nurse License active with the State of Wyoming in order to be put on the Substitute School Nurse list.

## Tier 1:

RN Licensed Nurses will be paid $\$ 160 /$ day ( $\$ 170 /$ day if substituting for the same school nurse for more than 10 consecutive work days).

Additionally, RN's can participate in a one-time "shadowing" of the district nurses over a one day period ( $1 / 2$ day at elementary, $1 / 2$ day at secondary) to observe the handling of our students' specific medical needs and district processes.
The applicability of this "observation" time will be at the discretion of the Special Education Director and paid for out of a Special Education grant at the daily rates listed above, and must be coordinated with that office.

## Additional Detail for Custodial Substitutes:

Effective July 1, 2018: On call substitutes hours are limited to 20 hours per week ( 5 days at 4 hours per day). After successfully completing two performance reviews: at 252 hours, and 504 hours worked as a substitute custodian, the sub will move to Class 1, Step 2 on the Custodian Salary Schedule. If a substitute is successful in gaining a regular position between their 252 and 504 hours of substituting with this district, they will be hired into Step 2 of the position they are hired into.

## Additional Detail for Bus Driver Substitutes:

* Effective July 1, 2018: On call substitutes hours are limited to 20 hours per week ( 5 days at 4 hours per day). After successfully completing two performance reviews: at 252 hours, and 504 hours worked as a substitute driver, the sub will move to Regular Bus Driver pay rate.
