COVID-19 Procedures for Isolation and Quarantine

Isolation expectations are in effect regardless of vaccination status

- If you test positive or are assumed positive for COVID-19
 - You are to isolate at home for 5 days
 - Return day 6 if fever free for 24 hours and symptoms resolved

Quarantine expectations are determined by student vaccination status

- If you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19
 - Unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated students will need to quarantine for 5 days
 - Return day 6 if no symptoms have developed
 - Fully vaccinated students who are not experiencing COVID-19 symptoms can continue to come to school (required to wear a mask for the full 10 days from exposure)
- *Testing is recommended day 5 after exposure or the first day symptoms appear if before day 5
- ** On days 6-10 mask wearing will be required of those students returning from a positive test or exposure if a negative test is received on day 5 from exposure a mask will not be required to return
- ***NCPS is following the approved CDC guidelines to define fully vaccinated as an individual who has completed their booster shot or is within 5 months of their 2nd Pfizer or Moderna shot or is within 2 months of their J&J shot.
