- The plan regarding utilizing the local garages for oil changes and state inspections. Transportation currently has a list of all garages and is planning on rotating all county vehicles through them as service is needed.
- Assessment results are back and will be presented on the next board agenda. All subject areas have increased in proficiency.
- Working with Eastern to offer classes to all service personnel interested in obtaining an Associate's Degree in the area/field the employee holds. The county will pay this out of recruitment/retention money.

Mr. Douglas Hines asked if the number of students attending the South Branch Career and Technical Center could be given to the Board. Ms. Van Meter stated they would have a meeting in September, and she would get the student enrollment for the Board then.

Ms. Van Meter advised the Board she may need to hold a special meeting next Tuesday just for hiring personnel for the county.

After this year, the buildings should be complete. Ms. Dixie Bean asked for an update on the high tunnel. Ms. Van Meter will get an update for the Board.
