

Pesticide Notification Request

According to Title 61, Legislative Rules, Series 12J, Integrated Pest Management Programs in Schools and Day Care Centers, it is my responsibility as a school administrator to notify you of your right to be informed of the application of Level 3 and Level 4 pesticides in our school.

Definitions:

“Pesticides” means the insecticides or herbicides that are to be sprayed in or around a building and the adjacent board-owned playgrounds utilized by a school, and that are used to protect the safety of the building occupants from the damage of stinging, biting, and disease carrying rodents and insects.

“Level 3 pesticide” means a pesticide which has a Federally Registered Caution Label that is registered for use in or around public buildings, schools, and commercial kitchens and that are applied as a crack and crevice application and/or spot treatment. This level has a four (4) hour re-entry period and is usually done after hours or when the affected areas can be closed off. (Students and employee could not re-enter this area for four (4) hours after the pesticide application). Exposure to building occupants in minimal.

“Level 4 pesticide” means a product which is registered for use in or around public buildings, schools, and commercial kitchens and is applied as either a broadcast treatment or as a space treatment. This product will display either a caution or danger notice on the label. This level of treatment has an eight (8) hour re-entry period in most cases and is usually performed when the school is closed.

If you wish to be informed twenty-four (24) hours or more in advance of the application of Levels 3 and 4 pesticides in our school, please sign and return the form below.

Pest management Plan in accordance with Title 61, Series 12J rules of the West Virginia Department of Agriculture. Pests are controlled primarily through preventive measures. When pesticides are required, the least Hazardous materials will be used.

Pest management methods are classified as Level 1, Level 2, Level 3, and Level 4, depending upon their toxicity and the degree of hazard associated with their application.

- Level 1 Non-chemical (preventive)
- Level 2 Least hazardous (low toxicity, non-volatile baits or dusts)
- Level 3 EPA Caution (limited volatility liquids)
- Level 4 EPA Warning or Danger (broadcast and space treatments, spraying and fogging)

As a parent or guardian, you have the right to be notified if and when Level 3 or Level 4 pesticides are to be applied. To receive such notification, please complete the information requested below and return this form to the principal.

Please Note: Level 3 and Level 4 pesticides will not be applied when students are in the areas being treated.
