1	January, May	30 minutes per test	2 tests X 2 times = 2 hours
2-5	September, January, May	45 minutes per test	2 tests X 3 times = 4.5 hours
Title 1: Grade 1	November, January, March, May	30 minutes per test	2 tests X 4 times = 4 hours
Title I: Grades 2-5	September, November, January, March, May	45 minutes per test	2 tests X 5 times = 7.5 hours

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
