General Purpose School Fund: The recommended Budget Amendment in GP School Funds increase expenditures of \$228,881.98. This is funded by an increase in revenues of \$55,120 and a reduction in Fund Balance of \$173,761.98.

Federal Projects Fund: #940 (CDFA 93.323: Center for Disease Control) Grant – Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) – Grant Award \$158,557.23

Cafeteria Fund: No recommended Budget Amendment in Cafeteria Fund at this time.

A motion was made by Joey Smith to approve Budget Amendment Four, with a second by Curtis Isabell. The motion carried 6-0 (roll call vote).
