Use Money to Reinforce Math Skills

1st through 3rd grade activities

Put your credit and debit cards aside and introduce your students to real money. Have your children sort the coins into separate piles, quiz them on how much each coin is worth and count out spare change. You can use change and bills to create addition, subtraction and multiplication problems. For instance, if it takes four quarters to equal one dollar, how many quarters will equal six dollars? 4 quarters x = 6
