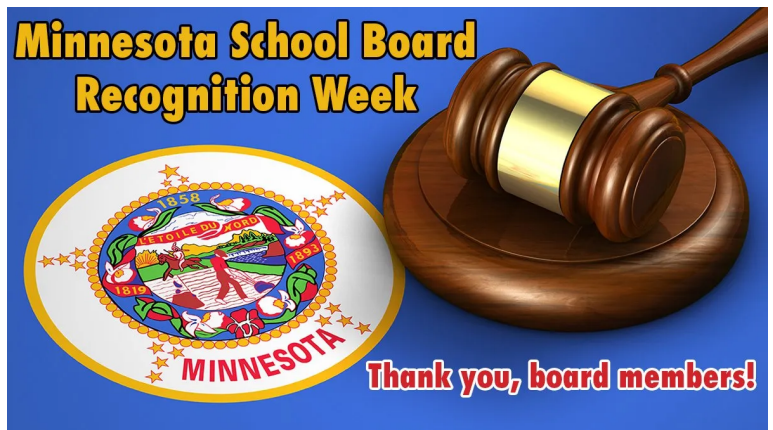

2021-22 School District Calendar Adjustments - The EGF ISD 595 Board of Education recently amended the 2021-22 school district calendar. Mother Nature has not been very cooperative this year and the school district has used several storm days. The original school district calendar, which was approved in April of 2021, listed June 2nd, March 11th and April 18th as storm make-up days. Due to the unusual 2021-22 school year, I recommended reinstating March 11th and April 18th as no school days and extending staff development days at the end of the school year in order to provide some designated breaks in March and April. The school district is well above the minimum number of school hours required by state statute and has the flexibility to adjust the number of student days.
