# **Executive Summary**

#### **Agenda Point:**

- Update on Safe Return to In Person Learning Plan
  - Follow state and local guidance in our response and mitigation processes. Continued follow between Rockdale School and the Will County Health Department.
  - Continue to SHIELD Saliva test every Tuesday
    - Some parents have "opted in" for SHIELD testing after declining in August.
  - Our staff has been #ALL IN as we implement more stringent plans. It has been an all hands on deck approach and our Rockdale staff have stepped up, as they always do.
    - Students are spread out six feet for Breakfast in the classroom (1st, 4th, & 5th Grades), cafeteria (2nd Grade), and in the gym (Kindergarten, 3rd Grade, and less than 10 MS students). This eliminates any contact tracing.
    - Students are spread out six feet for Lunch in the cafeteria and/or in the gym as we began using the gym January 4th. Two grade levels eat at each one of our four lunch periods. One grade eats lunch in the cafeteria and one eats in the gym.

#### • Extra curricular update

- Game competition was "paused" from January 4-January 12 out of an abundance of caution.
  - Practice continued due to our layered mitigation
- Game competition was reinstated on Thursday, January 13, 2022.
- Our Lady Rams Volleyball JV and Varsity played their first game vs. Gompers on Thursday, January 13.
   JV won 2 matches to 1, but Varsity lost a close 2 matches.
- Other schools have closed the building to any spectators, home or away, i.e., Fairmont. We continue to limit to two visitors per player, socially distanced six feet, masked, and no visiting spectators, but we stream the game.

### Good News Club request

- Email communication in late August about starting Good News Club again at Rockdale.
  - Mr. Fox, Ministries Coordinator-CEF of Illinois, Three Rivers Branch
  - It was communicated that we were strictly limiting visitors into the building so we held off on committing to any services. Our focus was in person learning while implementing our mitigation strategies.
- Recent communication on January 4 is that now they are offering a virtual Good News Club for students. It begins January 18th, but I stated that I wanted to ask the BOE prior to sending this out to parents.
- Asking for a recommendation from the BOE regarding sharing the "virtual Good News Club information"

#### 5Essentials Survey

- 5Essentials is an important survey that parents, staff, and students participate in each year.
  - Provides important information on how the school, school administration, etc. are performing in various aspects of education at Rockdale School, i.e., Effective Leaders, Collaborative Teachers, Involved Families, Supportive Environments, and Ambitious Instruction.

- We need a certain threshold of parents, students, and staff to complete the survey so we can see the results to make changes or celebrate the great things happening at Rockdale.
- Sent to staff on January 11 when the window opened
  - Typically the window is in the fall, but it was pushed back the past two years
- o On January 14, our 4th-8th Grade teachers received an index card that listed the student's name, ID # and birthdate so they can complete this in class one day soon.

  - Annual event hosted by the Joliet Chamber of Commerce where 2 Rockdale students can receive a \$1,000 Scholarship.
  - Students in 4th-8th Grade who have a GPA of 3.75 and higher are eligible. All students will complete
    the writing prompt, but only students who meet the criteria will move forward to the next step of the
    process at Rockdale
