Hello District 161 community,

The wintery weather remains for a bit longer and I look forward to putting it behind us. The main focus of this week's update is on our updated recommendation for changing the District 161 mask guidelines. Specifically, at Monday's Board of Education meeting, we will discuss moving to a mask optional policy on Tuesday, March 1st.

COVID-19 Metrics

As of today, we have 6 active COVID-19 cases between students and staff members in our 5 schools and district office. In addition, we have 0 outbreaks at this time. You can find our district and school metrics anytime by following this link. Please make sure to keep your child home from school if they are ill and also notify your building nurse if your child does test positive for COVID-19. The breakdown of the active student and staff cases is as follows:

UPDATED COVID-19 Protocols

At Monday's Board of Education meeting, we will be discussing making face masks optional on Tuesday, March 1st. We are making this adjustment based on several factors, including: our current COVID-19 dashboard data, the removal of the state and local indoor mask mandates, feedback from the District 161 community, and consultation with local school districts. If approved on Monday evening, the following COVID-19 protocols will be implemented, beginning Tuesday, March 1st:

- 1. Face masks and face shields are recommended, but optional for students and adults, with the following exceptions:
 - a. Pre-K and Early Childhood will remain masked.
 - b. Extra-curricular sports will continue to follow the Illinois Elementary School Association rules for face masks when competing. In addition, teams will follow all local guidelines when competing in other school districts.
 - c. Face masks are mandatory on all school buses, pursuant to federal guidelines.
- 2. Physical distancing in classrooms / other learning spaces
- 3. SHIELD testing / 5 day quarantines / Test to Stay
 - a. Weekly SHIELD testing will continue. All students and staff who are participating in SHIELD testing must wear a face mask while they are in the testing environment.
 - b. All students/staff participating in the test to stay program must wear a face mask for 5 days upon returning to school after quarantine.
 - c. All students/staff who are positive for COVID-19 must wear a face mask for 5 days upon returning to school after isolation.
- 4. Hand Washing/Cough Etiquette will be reinforced.
- 5. Contact tracing of positive cases will continue.
- 6. Encourage vaccination for all those eligible.

We are offering community COVID-19 SHIELD testing on Saturdays, from 9:00 a.m. to noon at Parker Junior High School. Additional details can be found <u>here</u>.
