BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

July 16, 2018

The Meridian Community Unit School District Board of Education held a regular meeting on Monday, July 16, 2018 in the Board Room. President Vicki Carr called the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m. The following Members were present: Vicki Carr, Tony Etherton, Chris Jones, Adam Herbert, Monte Hogan and Matt Roush. Member Jagger-Taylor was absent. Also present were: Dan Brue, Superintendent; Eric Hurelbrink, High School Principal; Andy Pygott, Middle School Principal; and Michelle Mathias, Recording Secretary.

Administrators gave their reports. Mr. Pygott reported that 14 students successfully completed the summer school program. Mr. Pygott has been busy building four book shelves for classrooms. Registration for school will be held August 2 for new students and August 7 for returning students. There will also be a blood drive held by the National Honor Society on the day of registration. Mr. Brue informed the Board that the journalism project in the great hall is completed and looks great. There are 76 plaques displayed that highlight Meridian groups/teams that have placed in state or received awards. Mrs. Moore and her students did a tremendous job with this project.

The District would like to thank the P&V Quickstop in Macon for allowing us to take possession of the past football and baseball trophies and pictures from Macon High School that were on display at the gas station.

Mr. Brue along with 4 other staff members attended a 2 day threat assessment workshop. This brought up the discussion of training for staff that will take place on the institute days in regards to safety measures in the classroom.

Mr. Brue reviewed the budget analysis. The fiscal year ended \$366,376 in the positive for the operating funds. He also reviewed the cafeteria program figures for the year.

The Board approved the consent agenda which consists of June financials, July disbursements, June minutes and the resignation of Denna Williams as high school PE teacher effective the end of the 2018-2019 school year.

The Board accepted the bid from Kohl's Wholesale to provide food items for the 2018-2019 school year and Prairie Farms bid to provide milk for the 2018-2019 school year.

The Board approved People's Bank of Macon, State Bank of Pana and Busey Bank as school depositors for the 2018-2019 school year.

Miller, Tracy, Braun, Funk and Miller were appointed as legal counsel for the 2018-2019 school year.

The Board adjourned to executive session at 7:04 p.m. and returned to open session at 7:14 p.m.

Kylie Hale was hired as an RTI/Title I Aide and Melissa Galvin as an elementary teacher for the 2018-2019 school year.

The meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m. The next regularly scheduled meeting will be August 13, 2018.
