# Folds of Honor Scholarship -deadline - MARCH 31st

Folds of Honor is a scholarship for dependents of Veterans and Active Military personnel whose goal is to financially bridge the gap left with the utilization of Chapter 35 (also known as the GI Bill, or VA Education Benefits: <a href="https://www.va.gov/education/survivor-dependent-benefits/">https://www.va.gov/education/survivor-dependent-benefits/</a>). This scholarship closes on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. Students will be required to provide the following information:

### Proof of Dependency

- Copy of Military ID (Front & Back)
- Birth Certificate
- Marriage Certificate
- Gross Annual Income Amount
- Copy of DD214
- VA Benefit Summary Letter

Students are also required to answer three essay questions:

## 1) Use the following to tell us about yourself:

- · What was it like growing up in a military family and how did it help mold you into the person you are today?
- What are some of your favorite things to do/places to go?
- Any hobbies, volunteerism or passions?
- · Why did you choose the school you're attending? Why did you choose your particular field of study?
- · Any school activities or groups that you belong to? Academic, athletic or other awards/accomplishments that you are most proud of?
- · What are your goals, hopes and aspirations for the future?
- · If you're graduating in the coming school year, what is your dream job? Where do you want to work?

### 2) Use the following to tell us about your service member.

- · When did they join the military and why?
- What were/are their job(s)? Special training they completed?
- · How many years did they serve? If retired, what year? Where were their duty stations?
- Awards, honors or decorations they received?
- Did they have other family members who served? What makes you most proud about your service member?
- Did they attend college before, during or after their service? Where and what did they study? What are they doing now?
- · Is there a special story or memory about your service member you'd like to share?
- If you could choose two traits or values you've learned from your service member, what are they and how has each been important in your life?

- · What does it mean to you to have the Folds of Honor scholarship opportunity available?
- · List specific ways this scholarship would impact you and/or your family and help in achieving your academic goals/dreams?
