WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Math

- In math we are continuing our measurement unit. We will continue practicing reading time on a clock and finding elapsed time. We will also start measuring liquid volume using customary and metric units of measure. We will have a test on Friday on time and liquid volume measurement. We will also begin of multiplication fluency challenge this week, look for a letter with details in the Red Folder Wednesday.

Science

- This week we are finishing up our unit on our crayfish and will take a test Tuesday about the crayfish. We will begin learning about various ecosystems, where they may be found, and their unique properties and characteristics.

Social Studies:

- This week we are continuing our mapping skills. We are using Studies Weekly Newspaper. We are also beginning SC History using closed readings.

Reading/Writing

- We are continuing to analyze and get to know the characters in our books. We will finish reading Because of Winn-Dixie as a class. This week's sight words are: **came, have, she, this, camp, damp, champ, stamp**
