Wynford Local Schools is located approximately one hour north of Columbus, Ohio and one hour south of the Lake Erie Islands. The school system is the hub of the community as the district is made up of six (6) townships near Bucyrus, Ohio. The district has an enrollment of approximately 1,200 students in a large rural area. The schools are centered on one campus with an elementary school building (grades PreK-5), and a new middle/high school building (grades 6-12). The district recently passed a bond issue to build a new middle/high school and renovate the elementary. The construction plan also included renovating the old high school into a community center.
