- Parents must submit a transfer request to have their student attend our school
- Our students are capped at 58 students for each grade level
- We use a Lottery to select the students that attend if we get more requests than spots available

About our educational model:

We believe relationships and routines are important to learning and strive to keep the students with the same teachers through the 6th, 7th and 8th grades

- > We strive to connect their education with real-world experiences through field trips
- ➤ We feature a core curriculum that requires 3 years of Band, Art, and PE/Health
- At 10th Street, we ask our students to live by a Code of Conduct that encourages Respectful, Responsible and Ready (the 3-R's) behavior
- > Students can still participate in athletics through their home middle school
- District transportation to and from school is provided
