Learning Tip

Grab and Count

Gather a set of objects, such as toy cars, blocks, or cotton balls. Ask your child to grab a handful and count how many they grabbed. Then, ask your child to predict whether you will be able to grab more or less. Try it and find out. Your child can also grab two handfuls and see which holds more, the left hand or the right.
