Learning Tip

Give your child a piggy bank and help fill it with spare change. Every month, empty it together and have your child sort the coins by denomination. Have him match the coins to the denominations indicated on coin wrappers or that you have written on paper scraps. This will help your kindergartner with counting, value recognition, and sorting, as well as hand-eye coordination.
