## **Learning Tip**

A fun way to practice consonant, vowel, consonant words (CVC words) is to get some plastic cups and label two of the cups with three consonants each like b, c, d, m, t, p etc. and then label the other cup with three vowels such as a, e, i, o, or u. Arrange the cups side by side starting with a consonant, a vowel and then another consonant, and have your child turn the cups around to try and make different words out of the combinations.
