## Learning Tip

A fun way to practice consonant, vowel, consonant words (CVC words) is to get some plastic cups and label two of the cups with three consonants each like **b, c, d, m, t, p** etc. and then label the other cup with three vowels such as **a, e, i, o, u**. Arrange the cups side by side starting with a consonant, a vowel and then another consonant, and have your child turn the cups around to try and make different words out of the combinations.
