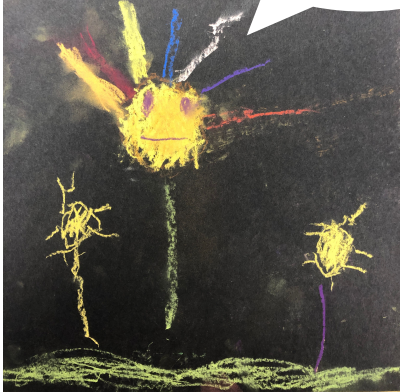
Art Room Newsletter

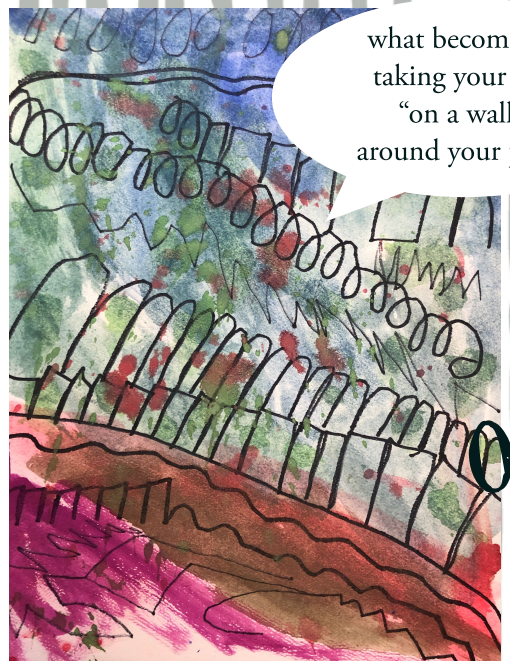
Flowers using lines! inspired by artist Yellena James

city skylines made from lines!



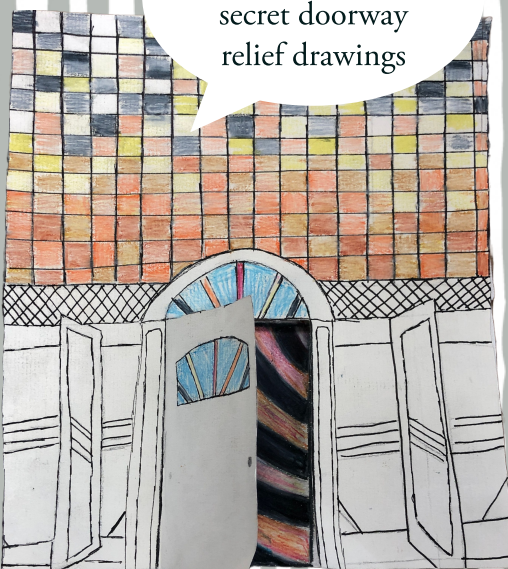
