DEFINITION:

Under the direction of the school principal, the resource teacher will provide support to instructional staff in order to maximize student learning. The resource teacher will help to facilitate professional development activities, student interventions, and extended learning opportunities.

- Locate and provide appropriate instructional resources to teachers and teams.
- Develop and oversee the implementation of instructional interventions for at risk children.
- Design and deliver professional staff development and coordinate people and programs.
- Speak and write effectively.
- Develop, conduct, and evaluate appropriate in-services, workshops, and meetings.
