- Reading intervention and extension focused on remediating learning loss
- Math intervention and extension focused on remediating learning loss
- STEM- extension and reinforcement of key concepts

#### Grades 6-12

### 6-8 programming includes:

- ELA/Writing -direct instruction and support focused on closing significant learning gaps
- Math-direct instruction and support focused on closing significant learning gaps

### 9-12 programming

 Credit Recovery for all subject areas with support, focused on students getting "back on track" for graduation

Readers and Writers Camp- 7th and 8th graders in need of support in the ELA

Exact Path- 6th, 7th, and 8th graders in need of intense remediation to close learning gaps.

PLATO Online Courseware-Course and credit recovery for grades 9-12

Students can recover lost credit

Students can get "back on track" for graduation

Students can elect to enroll in high-interest enrichment courses that would otherwise not "fit" into a traditional schedule All online courses are supported in person by a teacher certified in the appropriate subject area 4 days per week
