Overview of Special Education Process –

10 Basic Steps:

Step 1. Child is identified as possibly needing special education and related services.

- Child Find
- Referral or request for evaluation
- Parental consent

Step 2. Child is evaluated

- Evaluation

Step 3. Eligibility is decided.

Step 4. Child is found eligible for services.

- Individualized Education Program (IEP)

Step 5. Scheduling IEP meeting

- IEP Team Members

Step 6. IEP meeting is held and the IEP is written.

- Placement

Step 7. Services are provided.

- Accommodations, modifications, and supports

Step 8. Progress is measured and reported to parents.

- Progress Reports

Step 9. IEP is reviewed.

Step 10. Child is reevaluated.
