

Palmyra School District COVID PROTOCOLS

Effective March 7, 2022

The following will go into effect on March 7, 2022:

- Masks are optional in all school buildings/facilities
- Masks will not be required on school buses
- Social distancing will continue as much as possible
- Hand sanitizer will be available and its use encouraged
- Cleaning and sanitizing procedures will continue
- Masks and desk shields will be available as an option to students and staff members.



Mask wearing is a personal decision; please respect each other's rights.

Contact Tracing & Quarantines

- An individual who is sick should stay home and get tested
- Contact tracing will continue per Department of Health guidelines
- Quarantine will be required for those who have been in close contact to someone with confirmed COVID-19
- Quarantine begins on day 0 of symptoms or a positive test result as follows:
 - Days 0 - 5 individual must quarantine and may not be in school
 - Days 6 - 10 individual may return to school provided they are free from fever for 24 hours and symptoms are reduced or are gone
