Did You Know?

6. If you need to pick your child up early from school, please do so either **BEFORE** or **AFTER** their lunch period. Students are on the playground and teachers are not available for the student to get their personal items from the classroom. **Lunch Periods:** Kindergarten 11:55 – 12:55; First Grade 11:15 – 12:15; Second Grade 11:35 – 12:35; Third Grade 12:00 – 1:00; Fourth Grade 12:30 – 1:15; Fifth 12:45-1:30 & Sixth Grade 1:00 – 1:45.
7. All food items brought to school must have ingredient/nutrition labels in order to comply with the district Wellness Policy. Parents/guardians must consult with the classroom teacher at least 10 days prior to the event in order to discuss bringing any food items to the classroom. Food items need to be brought to the school office no later than 9:00am the day of the event. Food brought to school without prior approval from classroom teacher will not be accepted.
