

KidWind Challenge 2022

Sponsored by Liberty Elementary PTA, Invenergy, Washington Alliance for Better Schools, and the Bonneville Environmental Foundation

Please support our elementary and middle school students who will be competing at Liberty's Regional KidWind Challenge Event as part of our Conservation Club after school STEM program.

Each team has created a wind turbine capable of generating electricity. Teams will have time to test their turbines in a 4 foot wind tunnel and then 3 separate test runs in the wind tunnel will be recorded. They will have time in between tests to make small adjustments to their turbines. Before or after final testing the teams will have a judges interview without coaches. This interview is a big part of each teams overall score. The teams will also take part in an instant Solar challenge and a team Quizlet Live Challenge about Renewable energy.

This year Liberty Elementary is sending eight teams to the regional KidWind Challenge. We had 5 teams compete virtually last year and one team qualified for the national competition. This year we hope to send another team to nationals in real life.

This year the Washington State University Collegiate Wind Team will be volunteering at our event. College students will be on judging teams and running our wind tunnel. We will also have volunteers from our sponsor at Clean Energy Bright Futures on a judging team. CE has been our biggest sponsor getting our program off the ground. This is the first time because of COVID that they will see our work in real life.

The National KidWind Challenge is in San Antonio in May. The winning teams from our regional challenge will be invited to participate at the National Challenge.
