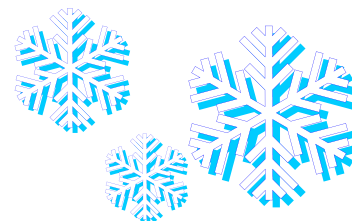

World Travelers

The 1984 school year brought Donna Stallings to the Glencoe teaching staff. She taught elementary classes for a while, moved to high school and now focuses on junior high classes. In 2004, she planned a student trip to the eastern seaboard in which about 20 students took part, and she has had at least one trip a year since that time. The trips evolved to the California Panoramic which included San Francisco, Los Angeles and San Diego and eventually turned to international travels to Puerto Rico, Rome, Italy, Greece, France, Switzerland and more. Making learning a lifetime goal for students was a high priority for her. As it turned out, students commented that the things they heard in the classroom had now come to life and they enjoyed this new way of learning. Parents began taking part in the trips, grandparents are starting to take these trips with their grandchildren and Mrs. Stallings also does trips exclusively for adults. Most trips last 12 to 14 days and can include up to thirty people. Trip participants are required to work and raise funds to cover their traveling expenses and Mrs. Stallings handles the planning and scheduling. The trip to the eastern seaboard, which includes Boston, New York City, Philadelphia and Washington DC, is a favorite and the tenth trip to those destinations is planned for 2023. Greece and Rome are on the agenda for 2022. As it turns out, some of those students who went on the early trips are now grown and still want to be included. International travel has opened doors for many of the students and introduced them to a fondness for more traveling.....and more learning. If you would like to support their efforts, you may purchase baked items at their sale during the Glencoe basketball tournament each year. They also have a one-day flower and plant sale each spring and this year it will be on April 6.

Thank you Mrs. Stallings for opening doors for international travels and bringing learning to life for our students and community.

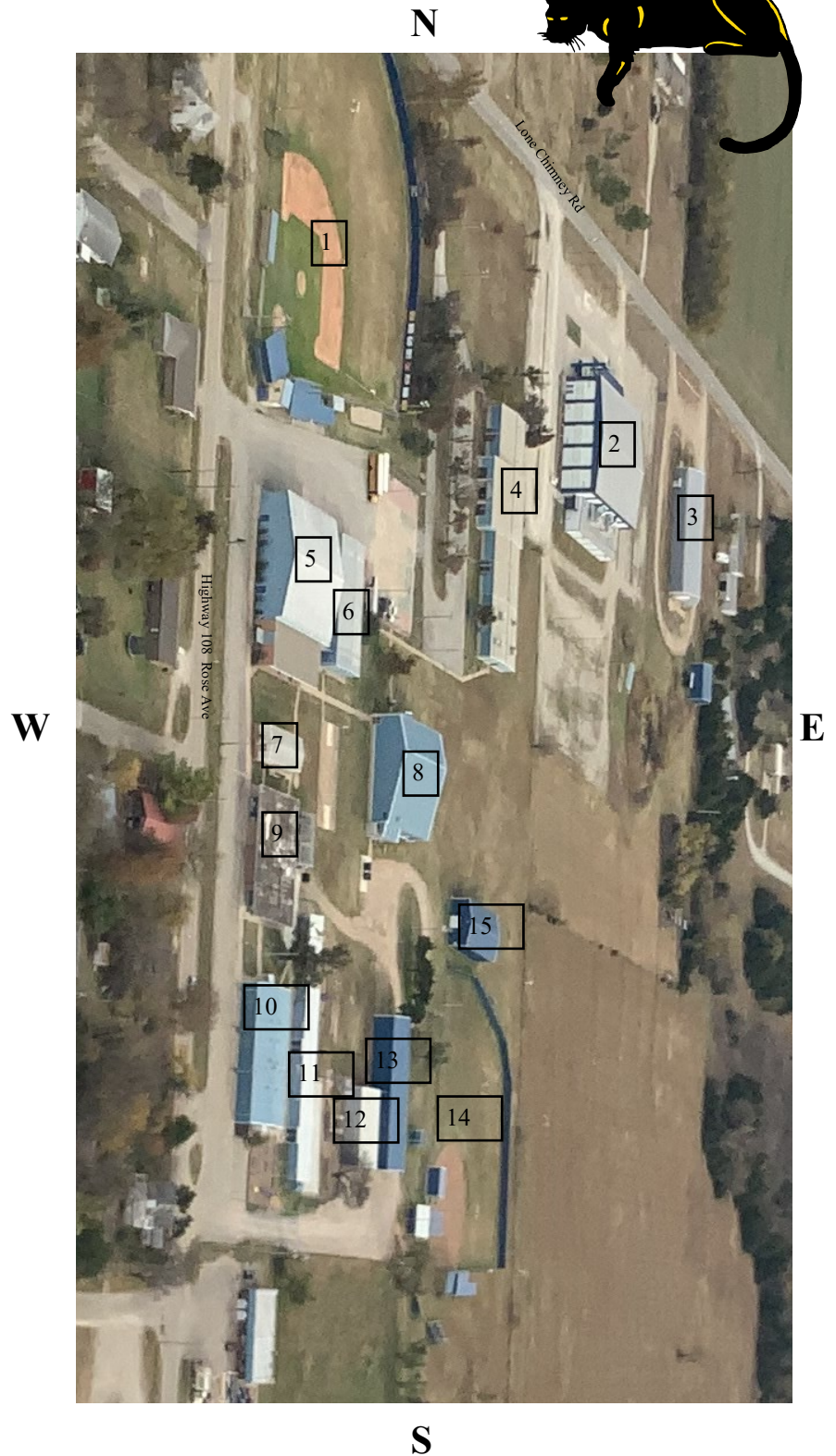
