

Dear **Snowflake High School Class of 2022**,

Some of you might need information on how to make the jump from taking NAVIT courses, dual enrollment, or TALON classes at our high school to attending Northland Pioneer College after graduation. We hope to give you a guide to help you through this process.

Do any of these questions apply to you?

- How can I finish the NAVIT program I started in high school?
- I want to take classes at NPC during the summer after I graduate. Will NPC pay for these classes?
- I want to take classes at NPC. I was in TALON or took dual enrollment classes at the high school and someone helped me sign up. How can I sign up for the semester after I graduate?
- I wasn't in NAVIT, dual or TALON during high school but want to get started at NPC. What steps do I need to take to get registered for the upcoming semesters?
- Can I get financial assistance to pay for classes at NPC?

Previous NPC (NAVIT, TALON, Dual) Students:

You already have an NPC student account, so your next step is going to be to meet with an academic advisor to select courses for the upcoming Summer 2022 and Fall 2022 semesters. Registration for Summer 2022 courses will begin on Monday, March 28th, and Fall 2022 registration will begin on Monday April 25th, so schedule an appointment soon with an advisor! You can find an advisor by visiting www.npc.edu/advising.

Students Who Have Not Attended NPC Previously:

You will want to begin your journey at NPC by completing the [admission application](#). Once you have completed the application, you can also schedule a meeting with an academic advisor by following the link in the paragraph above.

Financial Assistance

There are many sources of financial assistance available through NPC. We encourage students to **get moving on these processes quickly** as there are deadlines and processing times that might hold you up and prevent you from getting funding.

1. **Fast Track Scholarship**—Class of 2022 graduates looking to take Summer 2022 classes at NPC can use NPC's Fast Track Scholarship to cover up to 12 credits of tuition during the Summer 2022 session only. When registering for courses, you will need to submit a letter from your high school counselor confirming that you are on track to graduate this year. 2. **FAFSA**—An important first step in the financial aid process is completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Completing the FAFSA will help NPC determine if you are eligible for funds from the Federal Pell Grant. If eligible, this is a grant that does not need to be repaid. Be sure to select NPC as one of your school selections when you complete the FAFSA. Also, make sure you have an NPC ID and that NPC has your Social Security Number on file. The SSN is what is used to connect NPC with the information you submit on your FAFSA. In weeks following completion of the FAFSA application, be sure to check your NPC student email, and/or contact the NPC Financial Aid Office 928-524-7318 to make sure there are no documents pending submission.

3. **Scholarships**—NPC offers a wide variety of valuable scholarships that may apply to you, regardless of your FAFSA/Federal Pell Grant eligibility. - **NPC Donor/Institutional** – a variety of valuable scholarships provided by NPC.
 - **NPC Friends and Family** – the NPC foundation raises money and administers funds for many scholarships. The application period for most scholarships in this category are available now for the upcoming Fall 2022 registration period. Don't miss your opportunity to apply, most applications are due no later than Noon on April 14, 2022.
Some scholarships are available for Snowflake HS students only!
