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BICYCLE PERMISSION FORM

Regulations for Bicycle Riders:

Students in grades three through six may ride their bicycle to and from school, upon written request from their parent(s)/guardian(s), and with the approval of the Principal and/or Assistant Principal.

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of bicycle riders must assume full responsibility for their child(ren)'s safety, and realize that the school cannot be responsible for the bicycle while it is parked on the school grounds during normal school operations.

All bicycles must be secured to the bicycle rack with a lock/chain; no bicycle can be parked without a signed contract on file and a lock/chain attached to the bike rack.

TO THE STUDENT:

- You must wear a helmet

- Take the safest route to and from school.
- Keep as far as possible to the right side of the road.
- Be watchful and courteous, and give the right of way to all walkers and automobile drivers
- One rider per bicycle.
- Lock bicycle to the bike rack.
