Student Parking Requirements & Procedures

Parking Requirements:

- Must hold a valid driver's license.
- Students must be in good standing; No academic, discipline or attendance issues.
- All high school students will be required to park in the high school lot. No parking will be allowed for students at the middle school or elementary/unit office parking lots.
- Students must drive safely and will not store any dangerous materials or illegal substances in the vehicle.
- Students may only park in their designated parking spot.
- Any vehicle changes must be reported to the main office before an alternative vehicle is parked on school grounds.
- Parking Tags are not transferable and cannot be used or borrowed by other students.

- Place the temporary ticket in your car and then stop by the office to pick up your official tag. Tag needs to be displayed inside the car on the lower left side.

School Parking Procedures:

- Students who choose to park on school grounds other than their designated areas, may have their vehicles towed and/or be issued consequences by the school. Student parking without proper registration/parking tag:
 - 1st Violation = warning by HS office
 - 2nd Violation = assigned detention
- Assigned TVHS Parking Tag should be clipped to the mirror so it is visible through the front windshield.
- To ensure the safety of students and staff at TVHS, if school officials have reasonable suspicion of any dangerous materials or illegal substances in the vehicle, they have the right to search any vehicle while parked on school grounds.
- Failure to abide by the above listed rules, the policies of the Student Handbook, or the State of Illinois Rules of the Road, will result in loss of parking privileges.
