RAMS 23 - BENGALS 20

On Sunday, February 13th the Bengals battled the Rams at the Sofi stadium. The Bengals won the coin toss, but the Rams scored the first touchdown. At the end of the first quarter the score was 7 to 3. It took over 20 minutes of game time, but the Bengals finally found the end zone and they dug into their bag of tricks to get there. Cincinnati scored its first touchdown of the game on a six-yard pass from running back Joe Mixon to wide receiver Tee Higgins, catching the Rams' secondary offguard. The Rams scored their second touchdown and ended the second quarter 13 to 10.

The Superbowl halftime show was pretty cool with rapping stars Dr. Dre, Snoop Dogg, Eminem, Mary J. Blige, Kendrick Lamar & Surprise Guest 50 Cent. Dr. Dre and Snoop Dogg opened, and surprise guest 50 Cent closed the halftime show.



In the third quarter the Rams only scored a field goal but the Bengals intercepted Matthew Stafford's throw on the first play of the Rams next drive and the Bengals could only add a field goal after securing one first down. The Bengals were in the lead at the end of the third quarter, 20-16.

The only scoring play in the

fourth quarter turned out to be the game-winning play. Stafford led the Rams on a 15-play, 79-yard drive throughout the fourth quarter to secure the 23-20 victory over the Cincinnati Bengals. Kupp found the end zone after countless attempts to score a touchdown on the 15-play drive.

At the end of the game the Rams were given the trophy, Cooper Kupp won the MVP (most valuable player) and Joe Burrow had been sacked 7 times.

at the end of her run and crashed, getting silver instead of gold. This year in 2022 she entered again and took gold at 36 years old!




The United States ended up winning 8 gold medals and lots of others but placed fourth in overall medals.

The Right Sized Pet

Are you considering getting some new barnyard friends? If so here are some things to consider before getting something that you can't fully commit to.

The first factor you must consider is the area of land that they must stay on: how much, if there's grass, and the type of fencing. If you have over an acre or two you can think about the big animal list, although this list is only suitable for those who can pay for enough hay to sustain them through winter. These animals consist of horses, donkeys, and cows.

If you have around an acre of under you can consider the easier keeping list. The animals in this list can be anything from goats, sheep, miniature horses, donkeys, and pigs. Any pig should be suitable in an acre or less. Breeds such as kune kunes, julianas, and pot bellies. There are tons of different breeds of sheep and goats but they all house and manage about the same.

If you have a very small backyard and you're wanting something besides a dog, there are a few options. If your backyard is decently sized, two dwarf goats can possibly be housed in it as long as a shelter and proper fencing is provided. A small miniature pig is also a good fit for a backyard as long as you understand that all of your grass will probably be torn up. Pigs are very destructive when it comes to plants.

These are the animals you can keep in the different sized pens, hopefully this helps you and your family out.




