- 2. Any guest pass applicant with behavior problems at his/her former/current school or with the police department will be denied
- 3. No middle school students
- **4.** Guests who are 21 or older on or before May 20, 2022 will need administrative approval. Guests are responsible for setting up an appointment with Mrs. Green or Mr. Roberson seeking approval.
- 5. No late applications will be accepted FOR ANY REASON
- 6. INCOMPLETE applications will be denied immediately

STEPS TO COMPLETE AN APPLICATION:

- 3. Section 3 is to be completed by the possible guest (non BHS students) and parents.
- 4. Section 4 is to be completed by the possible guest's current school or employer. (**Sorry, any applicant who cannot provide section 4 will be denied**)

GUESTS WHO ARE NOT BHS STUDENTS:

- If he/she is a high school student at another school:
 - Guest Passes are to be completed by an administrator at the guest's current high school.
- If he/she is not in high school anymore:
 - A completed Guest Pass Application
 - A copy of a valid driver's license and proof of college status OR a letter of recommendation from their current employer. The letter of recommendation should include the following: A

statement of character regarding the applicant, name or advisor/employer, contact number and signature.

- If the guest is a BHS student, the application must be delivered to the main office
- <u>If graduated</u>, the application can be faxed or hand delivered to the main office.

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Prom Guest Pass Rules and Guidelines:

- Masks are mandatory to attend Belleville High School Class of 2022 Prom on May 20, 2022 at Laurel Manor. Masks must be worn during the attire event with the *exception* of dinner time.
- Belleville High School Dances are for high school age students.
 - Middle school students are prohibited.
 - Possible guests over the age of 21 need to make an appointment to meet with Mrs. Green or Mr. Roberson to gain permission.
- We reserve the right to deny any guest application for any reason.
- In order to gain admittance to the dance, the guest must arrive with the BHS student and present a photo ID at the door the evening of the dance. Guests without ID will be refused entry, as we don't know who you are, and have no way of checking.
- Any guest not following policies or behaving inappropriately will be asked to leave along with their BHS sponsor.
- BHS students who wish to get a guest pass for Prom must completely fill out the request form by the date required. Guests must arrive and leave with their prom date.
- Any inappropriate behavior during the BHS prom event(s) could result in disciplinary action, possibly including the inability to attend Commencement/Senior Party.
- If you are not currently in high school, college, or working...chances are likely you won't receive a guest pass to a Belleville High School dance.
