

Boise City Public School District is proud to announce a partnership with T-Mobile to provide free, wireless internet to students as part of T-Mobile's Project 10 million. T-Mobile has promised to provide these hotspots for up to 5 years for students in our district.

Each device will have unlimited data for the first year through the Emergency Connectivity Fund. After the first year, if funding is not renewed, the devices will be placed on a 100 GB per year plan. This is more than enough data for school work - but is unlikely to be sufficient for other purposes. These devices are intended to be used as an online homework solution for students that do not presently have access to reliable internet at home. Each device also comes included with a web filter to prevent students from accessing inappropriate content.
