Medical Careers 3&4

Grade 11-12

Medical Careers 3 & 4 are designed to introduce the student to the various knowledge and skill sets needed in the healthcare professions. This course will expose students to information that is pertinent to all aspects of the delivery of healthcare services. The ethical, legal and professional considerations involved in health occupations will be explored. The student will be introduced to First Aid and CPR issues and techniques. Local and national healthcare issues will be explored in class discussion, group teaching units and research exercises. Students will also receive a brief overview of Latin and medical terminology and Anatomy & Physiology. Students are strongly encouraged to pursue studies in these areas in their schedules. During Medical Careers 4 students will be eligible for a 10 week internship.
