

Entrance Age Requirements

A child may enter preschool if they are four years old on or before August 1 of the year of enrollment.

A child may enter kindergarten if five years old on or before June 15 of the year of enrollment. Younger students who do not meet the district's entrance age requirement for kindergarten but who are five years old on or before August 15 may be accepted if transferring from another kindergarten program if the principal or designee determines that placement of the student in kindergarten is appropriate. A child who is four years old on or before the districts start date for kindergarten may enroll in kindergarten, if the principal or designee determines that placement of the student in kindergarten is appropriate.

Students enrolling in the first grade may enter if they are six years old on or before June 15 of the year of enrollment. A student who is at least five years old on or before August 15 shall be permitted to enroll in first grade if the student attended at least 120 days of kindergarten in another state. A child who is five years old on or before the districts start date for first grade and has been identified as a highly advance gifted student in accordance with applicable state law may enroll in first grade, if the principal or designee determines that placement of the student in first grade is appropriate.

A legal birth certificate or other acceptable record shall be required for enrollment age certification.
