6. Update on 2021-22 AAPEAC Recommendations to the Board of Trustees
Myiesha Majors, Chairperson

- Create Parent/Teacher video, “What I Want My Parents/Teachers to Know...”

Myiesha Majors, Chairperson, shared that one of the subcommittees suggested the development of a parent/teacher video in 2020-21; it is still considered a possibility if one of the subcommittees would like to take on project.

- Develop Black History Month theme essay contest –

Myiesha Majors, Chairperson, shared that the cultural committee is further developing this recommendation.

- Schedule early engagement with schools at Back to School Night –

Jeannie Tavolazzi, Director of Instruction, shared that the district plans to continue the practice of introducing AAPEAC representatives to the school community at Back to School Night when we return to in-person family engagement events.

- Invite AAPEAC parents to attend Dr. Sharroky Hollie presentation with teachers in 2021-22 –

Jeannie Tavolazzi, Director of Instruction, shared that the district plans to invite AAPEAC representatives to future workshops facilitated by Dr. Hollie, if health and safety conditions permit.

- Support the district goal to hire and retain the most qualified candidates reflecting the diversity of our student population. Recommend the district recruit and hire African American teachers to increase teacher diversity to 7% by 2024.

Damita Walton, Director of Personnel/Pupil Services, shared information about LCAP action 1.4 related to hiring a diverse team of educators and provided the committee with current information on 2021-22 hiring/employment numbers.
